Having studied gastronomy at the Universidad Iberoamericana (UIA), Le Cordon Bleu and Baleares School of Tourism, Chef Jorge Sierra is passionate about Mexican and Iberian cuisine, as well as new culinary trends.

He has served as Executive Chef of Royal Caribbean International, InterContinental Group and Hilton Hotels as well as Corporate Chef of Cicero Centenario Group and Personal Chef for Sra. Maria Felix in Polanco, Mexico City. He took 1st place in Ritos and Retos of the Centro Historico in 1997 and appeared on TV Azteca Veracruz for the program Matutino Veracruz with Xavier Moranchel from 2003 to 2005.

One of his most significant positions was Corporate Chef of OHG, in charge of 32 industrial restaurants and responsible for more than 700 kitchen employees and 38,000 meals per day (2005). He obtained special recognition during
